

Getting to Paderborn

Arrival by Airplane

Paderborn has its own airport, but most direct flights focus on tourist destinations. Flying via Munich to Paderborn is a good option for all international travelers. If you prefer direct flights, there are various other airports in the proximity of Paderborn:

Airports for European Travel:

- Paderborn Airport (PAD) + 15min Taxi drive to the Welcome Hotel
- Cologne/Bonn Airport (CGN) + 3h train to Paderborn Main Station
- Dortmund Airport (DTM) + 1,5h bus/train to Paderborn Main Station

Airports for all International Travel:

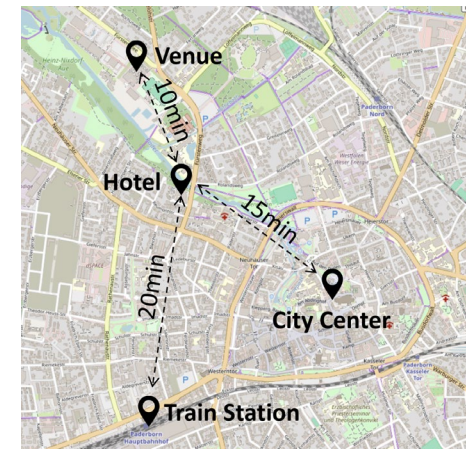
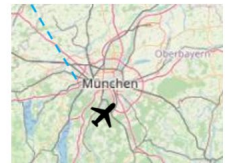
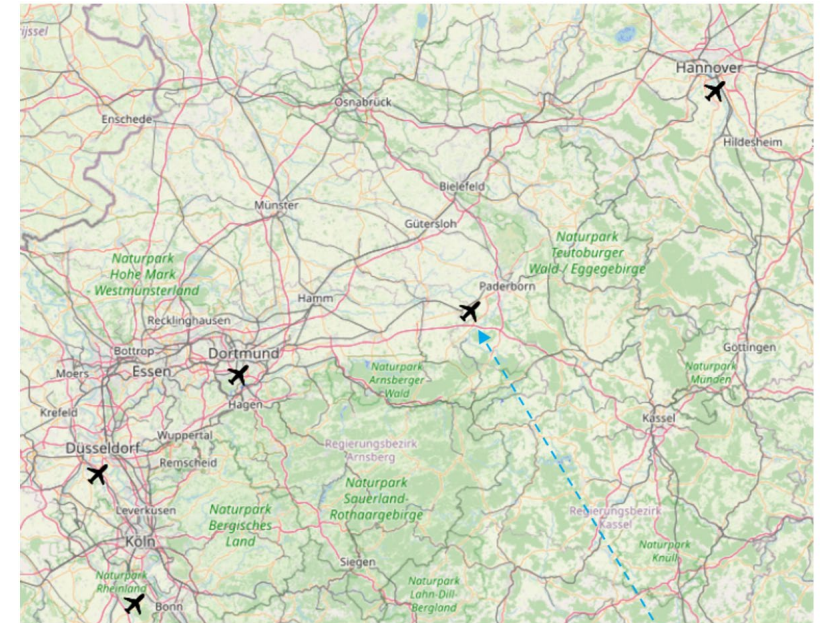
- Via Munich Airport (MUC) to Paderborn Airport (PAD) + 15min Taxi drive to the Welcome Hotel
- Düsseldorf Airport (DUS) + 2h direct train to Paderborn Main Station
- Hannover Airport (HAJ) + 2h direct train to Paderborn Main Station
- Frankfurt Airport (FRA) + 3h drive or 4h train

Arrival by Car:

- Parking spaces are available directly at the Welcome hotel and the venue.

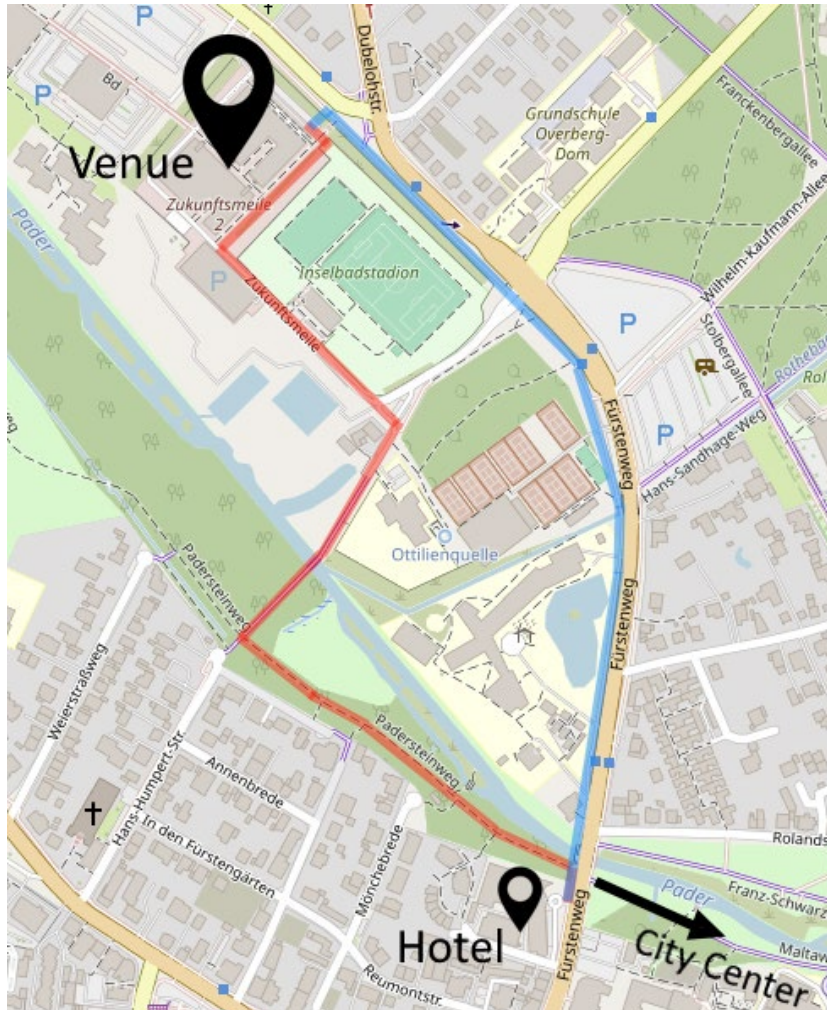
Arrival by train:

- From Paderborn Main Station it is a 20min walk (1.5km) to the Hotel.
- Taxis are available at the train station.
- Alternatively, you can take a bus (Line 9 towards Sande) directly in front of the main station (on the roadside of the main station) and exit at Fürstenweg. From there it is about 100m to the Hotel. Bus tickets can be purchased when entering a bus (cash payment only) or at Vending Machines at the bus stop.



Local Travel

From Friday to Friday, the venue is Zukunftsmeile 2 (ZM2), which is in walking distance from the Welcome Hotel (10 minutes). You can take the blue route alongside the street or the red route alongside the Pader. The address for the hotel is Welcome Hotel, Fürstenweg 13, 33102 Paderborn.



Parking

Parking is directly available at the venue (free of charge). Please use the parking garage (search for “ZM2 Parkhaus” on Google Maps or comparable apps). Do not park in front of the building as those are just short-term parking slots.

Parking is also available at the hotels.

Bus Routes

Venue, hotel, city center and Paderborn’s main train station are along the route of Bus No. 9. The schedule for Bus No. 9 can be found [here](#). Exit at the following stops for:

- Venue: Ferrariweg
- Hotel: Fürstenweg
- City Center: Westerntor
- Train Station: Hauptbahnhof

Tickets can be bought on the bus (cash only payment). A single ticket for bus rides costs 1,50€ if you pay in the bus or 1,00€ if you pay at a vending machine or purchase the ticket online.

Important: If you wish to pay by card, please indicate that when booking the taxi. Some taxis only accept cash payment.

General

Please make sure you bring comfortable shoes for walking to the university each day and getting around Paderborn. The hotel is approx. a 10 minute walk to the town centre for bars and restaurants. It should be warm and sunny in June but the weather can be unpredictable so a waterproof coat and umbrella may come in useful.
